Insufficient Nominations Election

Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

Nominations are called for Branch Conference Delegates (1 per Cluster) from each of the following Clusters:

- North Coast Region - Cluster 14
- Southern Region - Cluster 21
- Southern Region, Cluster 23
- South East Region - Cluster 30
- Metropolitan North Region - Cluster 33
- Metropolitan North Region - Cluster 36
- Metropolitan South Region - Cluster 41

Nominations, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Organisation, may be made at any time from 12:00 noon 07/06/2024.

A nomination form is available for electronic completion on the AEC Portal, www.aec.gov.au/ieb/. However, the nomination form must then be lodged in accordance with the Organisation's rules (see below).

Additional forms are available from the Returning Officer.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than** 12:00 noon Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) **on** Friday 5 July 2024.

How to lodge nominations, nominations must be lodged via the following method(s):

By Portal: Australian Electoral Commission Portal, www.aec.gov.au/ieb/

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a pdf file to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au.

The subject line of your email should include the reference: E2024/56 PFA Qld – nomination and (your name)

PLEASE NOTE:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.
3. You may call 03 9285 7111 to enquire about the status of your nomination.

Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00 noon Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on Friday 12 July 2024.

Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit a statement with the nomination form which is on a single (one sided) A4 sheet in Word doc format. The statements may include photographs and/or images

and comply with the Rules and must be received by the Returning Officer by 12:00 noon (Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST)) on Friday 5 July 2024.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 31 July 2024 and close at 10:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on Wednesday 28 August 2024.

Scrutineers

The appointment of scrutineers opens at 12:00 noon on 7 June 2024. A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
